1. Syllabus (Key Topics):

- **Officers Grade 'B' (General)**

Phase-I (Single Paper/200 Marks): General Awareness, English Language, Quantitative Aptitude, Reasoning.

Phase-II (Three Papers of 100 Marks Each/Total 300 Marks):

Paper-I: Economic and Social Issues : Growth and Development, Indian Economy, Globalization, Social Structure in India.

Paper-II: English (Writing Skills) : The paper on English shall be framed in a manner to assess the writing skills including expression and understanding of the topic.

Paper-III: General Finance and Management : Financial System, Financial Markets, General Topics, Management.

Interview: Interview will be of 75 marks.

- **Officers Grade 'B' (DEPR - Department of Economic and Policy Research)**

Phase-I (Two Papers of 100 Marks Each/Total 200 Marks):

Paper-I (Objective Type) (on Economics): Microeconomics, Macroeconomics, International Economics, Theories of Economic Growth and Development, Public Finance, Environmental Economics, Quantitative Methods in Economics, Current developments in Indian Economy.

Paper-II: (Descriptive Type) English –: The paper on English shall be framed in a manner to assess the writing skills including expression and understanding of the topic.

Phase-II (Two Papers of 100 Marks Each/Total 200 Marks):

Paper – I: (Descriptive Type) (on Economics): Microeconomics Module, Macroeconomics Module.

Paper – II: (Descriptive Type) (on Economics): Module on Quantitative Methods in Economics, Module on Indian Economy – Policy and Trends.

Interview: Interview will be of 75 marks.

- **Officers Grade 'B' (DSIM - Department of Statistics and Information Management)**

Three Papers of 100 Marks Each/Total 300 Marks

Paper-I: (Objective Type) (on Statistics) *and* **Paper-II: (Descriptive Type)** (on Statistics) : Theory of Probability, Probability Distributions and Sampling Theory, Linear Models and Economic Statistics, Statistical Inference: Estimation, Testing of Hypothesis and Non-Parametric Test, Stochastic Processes, Multivariate Analysis, Econometrics and Time Series, Optimization and Statistical Computing, Data Science, Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning Techniques, Database and Data Warehouse Management.

Paper-III: English – Descriptive, The paper on English shall be framed in a manner to assess the writing skills including expression and understanding of the topic.

Interview: Interview will be of 75 marks.

2. **Qualification Criteria:**

Educational Qualification:

- **Officers Grade 'B' (General):** Graduation in any discipline from recognised University with a minimum 60% marks (50% for SC/ST/PwBD applicants) or Post Graduation in any discipline from recognised University with a minimum 55% marks (pass marks for SC/ST/PwBD applicants) in aggregate of all semesters / years.
- **Officers Grade 'B' (DEPR):** MA/MSc in Economics or MA/MSc in Finance with a minimum 55% marks. (50% for SC/ST/PwBD applicants).
- **Officers Grade 'B' (DSIM):** Master's Degree in Statistics/Mathematics/Mathematical Statistics/Applied Statistics/Quantitative Economics/Econometrics/ Informatics/Data Science/Artificial Intelligence/ Machine Learning/ Big Data Analytics with a minimum 55% marks. (50% for SC/ST/PwBD applicants) **Or** Four Year Bachelor's Degree in Statistics / Mathematical Statistics/ Applied Statistics/ Quantitative Economics/ Econometrics/ Informatics/ Data Science/ Artificial Intelligence/ Machine Learning/ Big Data Analytics with a minimum 60% marks. (50% for SC/ST/PwBD applicants).

Age Limit:

General: 21-30 Years

OBC: 21-33 Years

SC/ST: 21-35 Years

5 Years Age Relaxation for Ex-Servicemen

10 Years Age Relaxation for General/EWS PwBD candidates.

13 Years Age Relaxation for OBC PwBD candidates.

15 Years Age Relaxation for SC/ST PwBD candidates.
